- The Indian National Army was formed in 1942 under Mohan Singh, who was an officer in the British army, with the aid of the Japanese in South-East Asia during the second World War. Mohan Singh was the one who suggested that Subhas Chandra Bose would be the ideal leader of a nationalist Indian Army.



DID YOU KNOW?

- Every year, Army Day is celebrated on January 15. On this day in 1949, Lieutenant General Cariappa became the first Indian to take over the post of Commander-in-Chief of the Indian Army from the last British Commander of India, General Francis Butcher.



DID YOU KNOW?

- The Indian army holds the record of handling the highest battlefield, Siachen Glacier which is 5000 meters above the mean sea level.

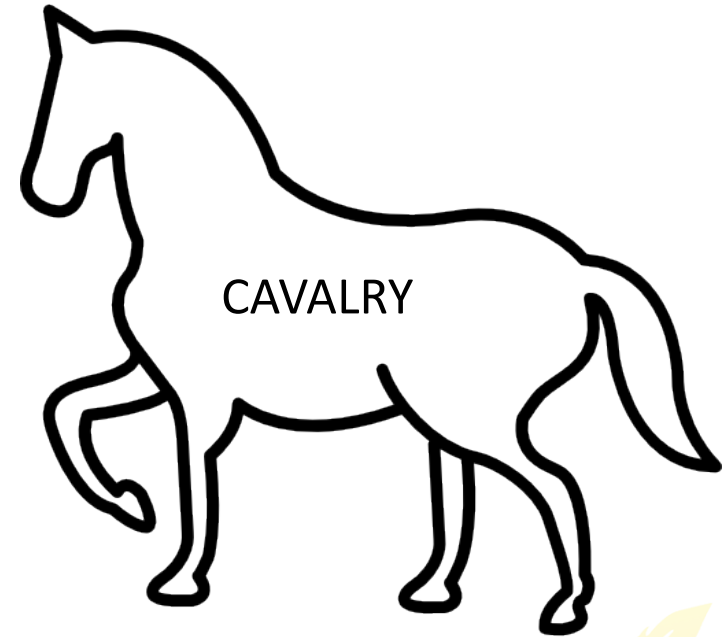
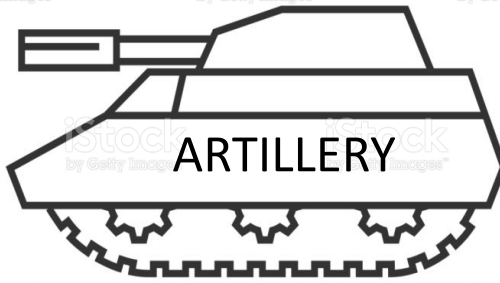


DID YOU KNOW?

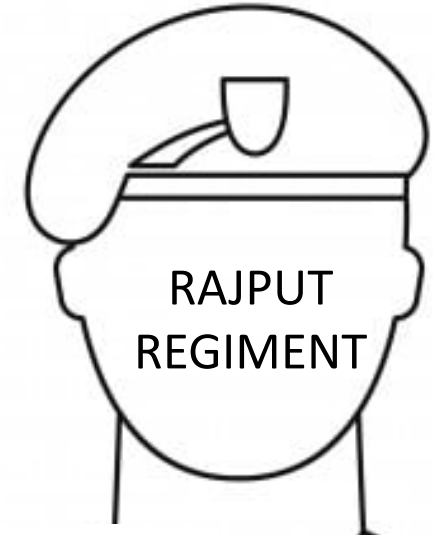
